

International forum of UNESCO Clubs "Opportunities for everyone"

From 16 till 18 December in Minsk (Belarus) there will be held International forum of UNESCO Clubs "Opportunities for everyone" timed to **25th anniversary** of Republican Public Organization «Belarusian Association of UNESCO Clubs».

Participants are more than **200 foreign experts,** representatives of the organizations connected with UNESCO Clubs from Sweden, Russia, Latvia, Belarusian scientists, teachers, students and representatives of UNESCO Clubs.

The respectable guests are **Daniela Popescu**, President of European and North American Federation of UNESCO Clubs, Centres and Associations, and **Yury Borisikhin**, President of Ural-Siberian Federation of UNESCO Clubs and Treasurer of World Federation of UNESCO Clubs, Centres and Associations.

There will be held a range of official and unofficial meetings on the basis of educational institutions in Minsk, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Belarus, National Artwork Center for children and youth and Belarusian Society of Friendship and Cultural Links with Foreign Countries.

The partner of the Forum is Ministry of Education of the Republic of Belarus.

The event is held within the frames of Measures of realizing of national youth policy in the Republic of Belarus.

Historical note.

Republican Public Organization «Belarusian Association of UNESCO Clubs» is a youth organization connecting 60 UNESCO Clubs in all regions of Belarus. It was established on December 17, 1989.

There are 4 main branches of activity: world culture, non-formal education, healthy lifestyle, information and communication. Yearly since 1994 in Belarus there are organized voluntary camps in places of historical-cultural and natural heritage, Winter and Summer universities of UNESCO Clubs, linguistic camps for children, Academies of UNESCO Clubs for young leaders and tutors, artistic open-airs, projects in the sphere of psychology and conflict management, leadership, healthy lifestyle, HIV-prevention, journalism.
